

# Chattahoochee Hills Eventing Schooling Shows

## Show Participation Guidelines

Follow USEF Rule Book, [www.usef.org](http://www.usef.org), except as below.

- Dress:
  - Half chaps with paddock boots are permitted.
  - Jackets are not required. Competitors should wear neat, conservative riding attire, appropriate for the weather conditions.
- Braiding horse is optional.
- Entry restrictions:
  - Jumping – a horse may be entered in a maximum of 4 jumping rounds
  - Dressage – a horse may be entered in a maximum of 3 dressage tests
  - Combined Tests – a horse may be entered in a maximum of 2 CT classes at adjacent levels
  - 3-Phase – a horse may be entered in one 3-phase class
  - A horse may be ridden by 2 riders with restrictions as below:
    - One CT and one 3-phase okay
    - For CT classes –Same level only if multiple sections offered
- Coaching:
  - USDF Intro Tests for all Amoeba and Tadpole classes may be called.
  - Limited coaching is allowed. Coaches may not accompany rider in the ring or on course but may offer moderate voice assistance.
- Eliminations:
  - CT & 3-Phase Competitors: Eliminated riders will be given permission to compete in the next phase as long as there is not a safety issue. Please go to the Show Office to request permission.
- Schooling:
  - Dressage: Prior to the show, dressage/flat schooling permitted in the warm-up arena adjacent to the lower dressage arena. No schooling allowed in the dressage arena.
  - Show Jumping: Show Jumping schooling is usually available Friday or after the show on Saturday for those that sign up for Class 41. Helmet and show bridle number are required. The arena is not manned. If you move any jumps or change the height, please put back to original position when finished. Once the course has been set for the show, usually late Friday afternoon, no additional schooling is permitted.
  - Cross-Country: Cross Country schooling is usually available Friday afternoon or Saturday except when cross country 3-phase is scheduled. Sign up for Class 40 to school XC. Helmet, safety vest, and XC pinney number are required.
  - Lunging: Lunging permitted in any grass area. Lunging is not permitted in any of the arenas.

## Show Participation Guidelines

- Time Penalties:
  - Show Jumping:
    - 1) Amoeba classes are timed but no time penalties are added.
    - 2) For all others the time penalty is 1 point per second over optimum time.
  - Cross Country:
    - 1) Amoeba classes are timed but no time penalties are added.
    - 2) For all other levels, the time penalty is .4 per second over optimum. For Beginner Novice, Novice and Training there is also a .4 per second speed fault for completing faster than the speed fault time.
    - 3) The time limit is double the optimum time. Exceeding the time limit is elimination.
  - If the SJ and XC course maps do not have the optimum or speed fault time included, the missing information will be posted on the score board and/or the show office.
